The Founder Director (1913 - 1977)

Shri R.N. Gulati was born on 27th December 1913 in a small village located on the border of the undivided India and Afghanistan.

With an excellent academic record he joined the North West Frontier Police of the British Govt. and was appreciated by the Governor of the Province for his gallantry 'services.

Looking for more challenges

he joined the Indian army as a lieutenant and opted for Artillery branch. A veteran of World war 2nd, he saw action in Egypt and other African countries. He was also awarded the Defence Medal, Certificate of merit for his gallantry services by King George IV.

Seeing the human suffering in the war, he branched off to the Indian External Service to serve the tribal of North East India with a missionary zeal.

Life was difficult but since he had the cause upper most in his mind, he continued to work for the upliftment of the tribals. After completing his tenure, fate brought him to this holy city-Varanasi.

His idea to educate the young in a different manner, gave shape to this 'Little Flower House " which was meant to be more of a home than a school for children.

A child among Children, his sense of humour further endeared him to the children who lovingly called him "UNCLE".

Even though he is not amidst us, but his ideals and visions are still alive which we are duty bound to follow and make his dream a reality.

A soul dedicated to the cause of education and social welfare, a heart that beat for the downtrodden, a mind devoted to the cause of upliftment of the education, an ingenious in modern techniques of education, such was the psyche of our founder SMT. RAJ GULATI, whom everyone respectfully called "MATA JEE". AN INSTITUTION BY HERSELF, she initiated methods and

practices in the field of education that will remain relevant for times to come.

Born on May 19, 1917, in a well to do family, with her father being a senior civil servant in the British Raj, she was educated in a good school in the erstwhile State of Western Punjab, now in Pakistan. Her upbringing was such that she grew to be a lady with a heart and mind.

In those days when the girls largely remained without education, she completed her college by doing a postgraduation in History and Political science. As her interest remained largely in education, she did her L.T. and joined the D.A.V. College, Lahore as a lecturer. Due to her devotion and sincerity, she was promoted as the Principal. After the partition of India she came to India, where she married an army officer Major R.N.Gulati who fully supported her ideals.

Even during the army tenure she was devoted to the upliftment of the families of jawans and her appreciable work made her win a lot of laurels.

Fate brought her to Varanasi, where her burning desire to bring about reforms in the field of education which was in a very inert form, gave birth to this institution which has since become the garden of education which everyone would treasure.

Her devotion and dedication has made "Little Flower House" today a towering entity in the field of modern education.

Although she left us on 28th October 2002, she is still guiding us today and we are duty bound to take this institution to new heights to fulfil her desire for working incessantly towards the development of the society.

THE PREMISES

1. Kakarmatta : The school premises is located on the Mahmoorganj – D.L.W. Road just opposite to Manduadih Railway crossing. It is 5 Km.from the Cantt Station and 4 Km. from BHU Gate. It has a sprawling campus with all modern facilities and has the best of the Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology Labs. A 21st century design by the famous Architect Smt. Lalita Das is under implementation and after its completion, it shall become an exemplary milestone in the architectural and educational world. The hub of the futuristic 21st century campus will incorporate all facilities like library, multipurpose halls, State of art, science labs, computer labs, gymnasium and other facilities.

2. Nagwa : The premises is located in about $\frac{1}{2}$ Km. from the Lanka Crossing having a picturesque surrounding on the bank of river Ganga and provide ideal atmosphere of learning. An architectural masterpiece by itself incorporated with all the facilities including playground.

3. Kabir Nagar: Located amidst one of the posh central colonies of Varanasi, it has spacious ventilated classrooms with all facilities. A four story structure to house all the classrooms/ sports/ labs and other facilities, is well equipped.

4. Sandaha : The premises is located in about 3 km. from the Ashapur crossing near to the world famous historical place Sarnath. The school provides ideal atmosphere for learning amidst its spacious green campus.



ADMISSION (General Conditions)

- **1.** A student seeking admission to any class other than Xth & XIIth will be eligible for admission to that class only if he :
- (I) Has been studying in a school recognized by or affiliated to this Board or any other recognized Board of Secondary Education in India.
- (II) Has passed qualifying or equivalent qualifying examination making him/her eligible for admission to that class;
- (III) Satisfies the requirement to age limits (minimum & maximum) as determined by the state /U.P. Government and applicable to the place where the school is located;
- (IV) Produces
- (a) The school leaving Certificate/ Transfer Certificate signed by the Head of the Institution last attented and countersigned,
- (b) Document (s) in support of his/her having passed the qualifying or equivalent examination.
- 2. Admission to class XI shall be open only to such a student who has passed:
- (a) Secondary School Examination (Class X Examination) Conducted by this board.
- (b) An equivalent examination conducted by any other recognized Board of Secondary Education/Indian University and recognized by this board as equivalent to its Secondary School Examination.
- (c) 75% of attendance is compulsory to appear in examination.

RULES FOR CHANGE IN SUBJECT

- I. Change in subject (s) in class XI may be allowed by the Principal but not later than 31st of August of that academic session.
- ii. The candidate shall not opt a subject in class XII which he has not studied and passed in class XI
- iii. No candidate shall be permitted to change his subject of study after Class XI.



Nursery: this is mainly a play way Nursery with emphasis on their mental and physical development with little or minimum reliance on books, based on latest research and with an experience of more than four decades. The main aims are:

- (I) Cognitive development
- (II) Inculcating good habits and manner.
- (III) Learning while playing involving motor control.
- (IV) Emphasizing the need to understand and appreciate their culture.

Here the students learn about themselves, about their family and their environment in a playway manner and the environment is provided to suit the child and not otherwise. It is strongly felt that it is easier to turn their attention on academics after they are aware of themselves and their immediate environment.





STREAM OF STUDIES

Nursery to Class X: All the subjects are compulsory.

Class XI: The learning areas will include:

1. English Compulsory for all Stream

Note: A candidate has the freedom to opt Hindi or English as the other language. Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Accountancy, Mathematics, Computer Science, Business Studies, Economics and Vocal Music.

2. Four electives out of the following :

Science Stream: Physics & Chemistry is compulsory. The student has to select any two of the following subjects-Biology, Mathematics, Computer Science, Psychology, Hindi or Sanskrit, Physical Education and Music.

Commerce Stream: Business Studies, Economics & Accountancy is compulsory. The students has to select one of the following subjects Mathematics, Computer Science, Physical Education, Psychology, Hindi, Sanskrit, Music.

All commerce students will have to take computer as an additional subject for one year. This course will give them a good orientation and if they so desire they can continue and appear for the Board Examination with the said subject, by discontinuing any other subject.

Humanities Stream: Business studies, Psychology, Mathematics, Economics, History, Political Science, Hindi or Sanskrit and Physical Education.

Financial Market Management (FSE) Mumbai. The course will have the following core subject :

Class XI: **1.** Accounting for Business 2. Introduction to Financial Market 3. Computer Application in Financial Market.

- 5. Physical & Health Education

OUR APPROACH TO EDUCATION

The school since the beginning, has a concept of continuous and comprehensive assessment rather than mere examination, which goes beyond rote learning and includes factors like attitude, emotions, competencies and skill.

Due weightage is provided for softer subjects like art, music, life skill, work experience etc. Every effort is made to reduce the stress of the child and to provide application oriented methodology using Mathematics, English, Commerce laboratories so that self-learning is induced among students and sense of responsibility towards society and environment.

APPRECIATING THE ARTS Both visual and performing arts are essential to the curriculum and are considered to be the critical components in child development. The faculty emphasizes on appreciation of all arts and enrichment they provide in school and in life.

The well rounded visual art curriculum including drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, collage etc. is followed. Students work with a wide variety of media to produce two or three dimensional projects while mastering the various techniques and fundamental concepts.

Singing, music theory and music appreciation begins in the earliest years. Music assemblies also provide opportunities for students to perform before their classmates.







(c) Debate, extempore speech, Quiz competitions in Science, General Knowledge and Current affairs are a regular bi-monthly feature.

(d) Music & Foreign Language classes are the part of the curriculum in junior class.

(e) As a part of the social responsibility programme a special literacy drive is undertaken by the children and they have in this process, adopted about 100 children of brick kiln worker whom they visit regularly.

Hostel: Hostel facilities for Boys/Girls separately are ultra-modern, comfortable and individual attention is given to the security and safety of the inmates. The hostel is provided with the State of art amenities including telephone and internet facilities so that inmates can feel at home. Hygienic food as per norms provided by the dietician along with mineral water from our plant will be made available to all students. An attractive pleasant comfortable and glorious in house hostel camps is one of the attractive feature of the L.F.H school, Varanasi.

Transport Facility: The school has its own fleet of transport, which connect the school to all parts of the city. Transport fees will be charged on a bimonthly basis. However, on availing the transport facility till October, students will not be permitted to discontinue this facility. In the event of leaving transport the candidate will have to pay the complete dues till the end of the session. Transport fees for May and June will be payable in May. Children will be picked up and dropped on the main road at fixed stop. Student should bring the bus pass everyday issued by the school and in event of loss, a duplicate can be obtained from the office on payment of Rs.15/-
